
MISSION










PRINCIPLE 2: ARTICULATION OF THREE SUBSYSTEMS OF WORK





It is the Basic Unit of the Police that attends to the needs of the neighborhoods, their population, economic and environmental situation, coordinated by the CHIEF OF SECTOR. This work is in a constant process of improvement.

Currently, the work of the chief of sector is being automated. The principal component of the work is preventing and reducing criminal activity. The automation permits us to improve our capacity and response to the citizenry in matters of security.

PRINCIPLE 3: SECTORS

INTEGRAL ATTENTION FOR WOMEN VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC OR SEXUAL VIOLENCE OR TRAFFICKING



Implementation of the strategy of protection of the lives of women and the Women for Life, Women for Peace and Wellbeing Campaign

Inauguration of 253 Women's Police Stations in municipalities around the country and inauguration of 249 national delegations to strengthen the specialized attention to crimes against the lives and dignity of women.



 - Vehicle registration certificates and drivers license certificates.







RATE OF HOMICIDES PER 100,000 INHABITANTS 2007-2022




Complaints per 100,000 inhabitants / Years 2007-2022




Crimes & Misdemeanors / Years 2007-2022




Risk of being a victim of delinquency/Years 2007-2022




